Conditions for Using the St Peter's Equestrian Facilities

These facilities are primarily for the use of St Peter's students, who have priority over all other users. St Peter's School is happy to allow use by other riders by arrangement and subject to the conditions below.

- Generally the facilities are unavailable between 3.30pm and 5.30-pm Tuesday to Thursday during term times, unless otherwise arranged
- All yards must be vacated by 3.15pm Mon – Thurs during term time
- **All users must have a completed a Hazard Identification form prior to entering the Arena.**
- **All users must have a confirmed booking before using the grounds**

Bookings should be made during business hours Monday – Friday, 8 am – 5 pm. Any booking received outside of normal business hours, will be actioned on the next business day.

Conditions of Use

- The person booking the grounds is responsible for paying fees, seeing all conditions are adhered, to, checking cleanliness, tidiness, secure windows & buildings before they leave
- **All manure and hay must be promptly removed from the arena, carpark, washbay and yards and placed in the muck heap**
- Place all other rubbish in the bins provided
- **The sand arena must be dust-free before & mucked out after each riding session**
- Make arena dust-free use by either watering it or use after recent rain
- No dogs – leave them at home or in a vehicle
- Do not tie horses directly to rails – please use twine attached to a post
- If your horse chews rails please apply anti-chew (Cribbox) to avoid damage
- Security locks the gates at 9.30pm each night. Please use the main school entry if arriving after this time. Kitchen, toilets & showers available by arrangement through the Facility Hire Co-Ordinator
- All gear used must be safe, all mounted riders must wear a correctly fitted, fastened safety helmet
- If using the jumping equipment in the sand arena:
 - **Please ask before you move jumps that are set up as a course**
 - Otherwise the jumps must be moved regularly to avoid making deep tracks or holes in the arena surface
- All painted rails must be supported in cups, not lying on the sand and not used as ground poles- use the short thick white or pink yellow rails for this
- With permission, you may arrange to take extra equipment out of storage, but it must be returned there after use
- Report all breakages/damage - depending on circumstances the costs of repair may be charged to the owner/rider responsible for the damage
