The School offers three payment options:

- Annually:** Either: payable prior to 20 November 2018, with a 2% discount applied
Or: payable prior to 21 January 2019, with a 1% discount applied
- Termly:** payable in four instalments on 21 January, 22 April, 22 July and 21 October, or
- Monthly:** payable by the 20th of the month, spread over 10 instalments, January to October.

Interest will be charged on overdue account balances, at a rate of 2% per month.

SCHEDULE OF DOMESTIC FEES

Notice of withdrawal

One full term's notice of intention to withdraw from St Peter's School is required. Should that length of notice not be given, then a penalty of the next term's fee is payable. Principal's discretion may be applied for in exceptional circumstances.

Notice of intention to withdraw from boarding to become a day student requires one full terms notice except after Week 6, Term 3. In this situation, a penalty of boarding fees until the end of the year is payable.

Imprest Deposit (Alumni Membership)

An imprest deposit (\$250) is payable on entry to the School. The imprest deposit will be converted into fees for life membership of the St Peter's School Alumni Association for your child when they leave St Peter's.

St Peter's Parents Association

There is an annual charge for membership of the St Peter's Parents Association (\$60 per family).

Buses

Buses run from Cambridge, Hamilton (four), Leamington, Maungatautari, Matamata, Matangi, Morrinsville, Putaruru, and Te Awamutu and are available for day pupils. The price to be advised prior to the start of each year; payment is in eight instalments. The details of current bus schedules are available from the School Office.

Non-Resident Fees

International fees apply for students who do not have New Zealand or Australian Permanent Residence and whose parents do not have a current New Zealand work permit. Details can be obtained from the International Office.

Multi-pupil discount

A discount of 10% off boarding and tuition fees is allowable for the 3rd and subsequent children of a family attending the School concurrently.

Lunches

School lunches are available for all students at no additional cost. Day students are welcome to bring their own lunch, but no refund will be made.

ESOL, Pastoral Care & Homestay

ESOL

For New Zealand Residents and Citizens who have English as a second language and language support if needed - no fee.

Pastoral Care

For students who do not have parents or a close relative living in New Zealand the International Department will arrange and vet homestays and monitor student welfare - \$850.

Homestay

Homestay accommodation for leave weekends and holidays approximately \$2,800 per annum if required.
