LIKELY SUBJECT SELECTIONS FOR DISCUSSION

Please circle the six subjects (in the white boxes on the next page) you intend to study for your IB Diploma. In general, you must choose one subject from each group. Please circle HL or SL (you may circle more than three for Higher level study if you are unsure). For all subjects other than Mathematics this is indicative only as you do not need to choose until the programme is underway. However, for Mathematics your selection will determine which class you are in as the classes are all separate.

Exceptions: If you do not wish to study a subject from Group 6 you may choose another subject from either Group 2, 3 or 4. Group 6 is optional. Alternatively, you could choose two Group 6 subjects, and ESS as a subject that fits Group 3 and 4.

In some circumstances, if a university requires it, you may choose a non-regular selection of subjects, which means applying for a 'Non-Regular' Diploma. Evidence is required from a university indicating certain subjects are necessary for entry into a particular course (e.g. Vet Science at Massey). If appropriate the IB Coordinator will then apply for you to complete a 'non-regular' diploma.
